Subject: Commitment to purchase a share of the AI Compute access time from the selected AIGF

Dear Sir/Madam

We refer to Regulation (EU) 2021/1173 establishing the European High-Performance Computing Joint Undertaking (hereinafter “Joint Undertaking” or “EuroHPC JU”) as last amended on 20th January 2026¹ and in particular recital 13 and Article 12b (4) thereof, as well as to Articles 1 (4) and 18 of the above-mentioned Joint Procurement Agreement.

On this basis, the Kingdom of Spain hereby commits for Phase I to match the EU contribution in the territory of the Kingdom of Spain up to EUR 200 million², to purchase its share of AI compute access time to the highest ranked AIGF Consortium in Lot 2 selected for funding/awarded the Framework Contract in the territory of the Kingdom of Spain, following the outcome of the selection and award process to be performed by the EuroHPC JU in accordance with the Regulation and the Joint Procurement Agreement.

Any budget surplus from Phase I shall be used in the purchase of AI compute access time and services in Phase II from the same highest ranked AIGF Consortium, in the case Phase II is

launched according to the call conditions.

This commitment applies only to the purchase of AI compute access time from the constituent site in this territory that is a full-scale AIGF for Lot 2.

The committed amount referred to above includes an allocation of EUR 200 million drawn from the funds of the Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF).

The Kingdom of Spain could indicatively commit for at least additional EUR 50 million³ in Phase II, independent from any budget surplus from Phase I, also drawn from the funds of the Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF).

This commitment shall take effect upon the selection of an AIGF consortium and award of a Framework Contract to it by the EuroHPC JU and shall be implemented in accordance with relevant contractual arrangements, including the Joint Procurement Agreement, the Framework Contract and related Specific Contracts, and any Administrative Arrangement signed with the EuroHPC JU for that purpose.
