Subject: Commitment to purchase a share of the AI Compute access time from the selected AIGF

Dear Sir/Madam

We refer to Regulation (EU) 2021/1173 establishing the European High-Performance Computing Joint Undertaking (hereinafter “Joint Undertaking” or “EuroHPC JU”) as last amended on 20th January 2026¹ and in particular recital 13 and Article 12b (4) thereof, as well as to Articles 1 (4) and 18 of the above-mentioned Joint Procurement Agreement.

On this basis **the Republic of Latvia**, represented by **the Ministry of Economics of the Republic of Latvia**, acting as National Contracting Authority for the purposes of the Joint Procurement Agreement hereby commits for **Phase I** to match the EU contribution in the territory of Latvia up to **EUR 15,000,000**². *Such commitment shall in any event become definitive at the latest 6 weeks prior to the end of the time-period for the submission of tenders*, to purchase

its share of AI compute access time to the highest ranked AIGF Consortium in in selected for funding/ awarded the Framework Contract in the territory of **Finland** in the Lot ultimately determined by Finland, following the outcome of the selection and award process to be performed by the EuroHPC JU in accordance with the Regulation and the Joint Procurement Agreement.

Such commitment is conditional upon the relevant AIGF multi-country / multi-site consortium including **a physical constituent site located in the territory of Latvia**, from which Latvia's AI compute access time will be acquired. The above-mentioned guaranteed purchase of AI compute access time of up to EUR 15,000,000 is equivalent in value to up to 17% from at least EUR 88,200,000€ in IT capital expenditure investment for a small scale AIGF in the territory of Latvia linked to a full-scale constituent site in Finland.

The Republic of Latvia further specifies that any national financial commitment for Phase II is conditional upon the implementation of the AI Gigafactory infrastructure in Latvia and the availability of funding.

This commitment shall take effect upon the selection of an AIGF consortium and award of a Framework Contract to it by the EuroHPC JU and shall be implemented in accordance with relevant contractual arrangements, including the Joint Procurement Agreement, the Framework Contract and related Specific Contracts, and any Administrative Arrangement signed with the EuroHPC JU for that purpose.
