DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EuroHPC JOINT
UNDERTAKING No 25/2026

Approving the proposals selected for funding pursuant to the evaluation of
the Call for Proposal for the Extreme Scale Access Call (Seventh cut-off)

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EuroHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2021/1173 of 13 July 2021 on establishing the European High Performance Computing Joint Undertaking and repealing Regulation (EU) 2018/1488, as last amended by Council Regulation (EU) 2026/150 of 16 January 2026 on amending Regulation (EU) 2021/1173 on establishing the European High Performance Computing Joint Undertaking (hereinafter, “the JU Regulation”), in particular Article 38(1) thereof,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2018/1488 and, in particular to Article 13 thereof,

Having regard to the Governing Board Decision No 18/2021 of 1 October 2021 on the Access Policy to the Union’s share on the access time to the pre-exascale and petascale supercomputers,

Having regard to the Governing Board Decision No 66/2025 of 13 January 2026 on Revision of the Access Policy of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking Supercomputers (Amendment No 5),

Having regard to Governing Board Decision No 25/2022 of 20 September 2022 approving the Call for Proposal and Terms of Reference for the Extreme Scale Access Call.

WHEREAS

- (1) The Governing Board shall define the access rights to the Union's share of access time to the EuroHPC pre-exascale supercomputers and petascale supercomputers and to the Union's share of access time of these supercomputers.
- (2) Pursuant to the Decision No 25/2022 of 20 September 2022, the Governing Board of EuroHPC Joint Undertaking approved the call for Proposal and Terms of Reference for the Extreme Scale Access Call.
- (3) The call for proposals was opened on 24 September 2025 providing deadline of the seventh cut-off date on 27 October 2025.

- (4) By 27 October 2025, 42 proposals were submitted and 40 were administratively accepted in response to the call requesting access to seven systems of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking: Leonardo Booster, Leonardo DCGP, LUMI-C, LUMI-G, MareNostrum 5 ACC, MareNostrum 5 GPP and JUPITER Booster. From the total 40 proposals administratively accepted, 35 were submitted to the Scientific Access Track, 4 to the Industry Access Track and 1 to the Public Administration Access Track.
- (5) The evaluation was performed following the Access Policy guidelines and the Terms of Reference approved by the Governing Board by Decision No 25/2021 of 12 November 2021 and Decision No 25/2022 of 20 September 2022, respectively.
- (6) The evaluation of the proposals for this call was carried out according to the rules and procedures of Horizon 2020 and HE. The proposals were verified for compliance with the admissibility requirements and eligibility conditions of the call. As a result of the evaluation, 31 applications were ranked above threshold.
- (7) The Governing Board is requested to approve the ranking of applications to receive extreme scale access time to EuroHPC supercomputers on the basis of the seventh Extreme Scale Access Cut-Off Evaluation Report.
- (8) The Executive Director has submitted to the Governing Board for approval the ranked and awarded list of applications attached as Annex 1.
- (9) The Governing Board took note and acknowledged the Report of the Executive Director on the outcome of the call, which includes the Extreme Scale Access Cut-Off Evaluation Report with its annexes.
- (10) The Executive Director is required to implement the decision of the Governing Board.
- (11) The Governing Board reviewed and approved the proposals selected for funding pursuant to the evaluation of the call for proposals for the Extreme Scale Access Call and the Governing Board

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

With regards to the call for proposal for the Extreme Scale Access Call (seventh cut-off), the Governing Board approves the ranking list of applications selected to receive access time to EuroHPC supercomputers, included in Annex I.

Article 2

The Executive Director shall inform the applicants, by email, of the result of the evaluation. The successful applicants shall be contacted by the technical teams of the assigned supercomputer centre to begin the onboarding procedure. The applicants will be requested to sign an Acceptable User Policy before accessing the system.

Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
